

A SIMPLE OPERATION TO ENHANCE RESTORER PERFORMANCE

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Abstract - A simple operation for enhancement of restoration performance is described. Those parts of the brain not required in the performance of the restorer's duties may be cheerfully discarded, although this abstracter feels rather strongly that they could be of use for something - perhaps native tanning of skins? Whatever the case, the success of the operation is spouted out in typically Soviet fashion with loud bombast and overloaded fake modesty.

1 Introduction

Is title of journal wrong is not setback describe here but glorious advance for Soviet conservation science in paradise of workers and farmers (1). Also is technique describe here pioneer on willing Soviet volunteers for glory of Mother Worker State, but found more application in decadent West. Further elaborations from this point eventually.

Brain is constructed so that right side controls aesthetic and left side controls pragmatic. Creative people most often found in restoration - attracts people ill-educated unclear thinking.

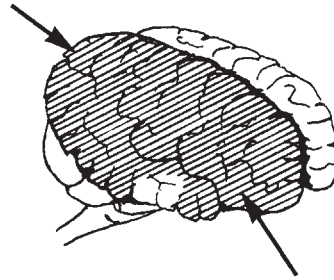
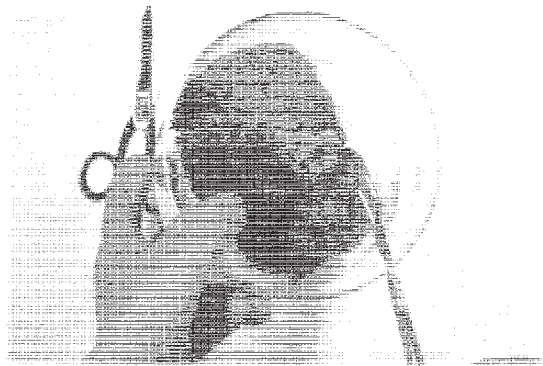


Fig.1. Useless parts of brain show in shading.

Useless parts of brain shown in Fig.1. All parts which having no function to worker/restorer shown shading indicating which parts worker/hero/surgeon remove and discard. Note that all pragmatic actions of brain on left side allowed to proceed normally (3).

3 Surgery

Skull bone of glorious volunteer cut open with saw and useless parts pulled out. Is no need for skull bone with nothing in so half head only left. Head sewn up and worker/restorer sent back to restoration factory (Fig.2).

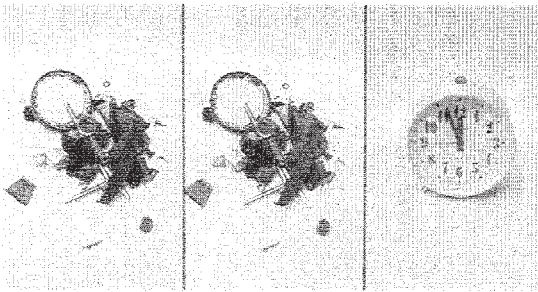


Fig.3. Object before treatment (left), treated by test subject (centre), treated by control subject (right).

4 Conclusion

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Résumé - On décrit un procédé simple pour rehausser la valeur d'une restauration. Les parties de cerveau qui ne sont pas requises pour accomplir les tâches d'un restaurateur peuvent être joyeusement mises de côté, bien que ce réviseur croit fermement que ces parties pourraient servir à autre chose - peut-être pour tanner les peaux. Quel que sont le cas, le succès de l'opération est dégoisé d'une façon typiquement soviétique, avec une enflure bruyante et une fausse modestie exagérée.
